

M3 Family Medicine Student Expectations

Expectations/Important Considerations:

1. Review your orientation packet carefully.
2. Meet with your responsible faculty about the rotation within the first 2 days.
3. Be on time and ready to work, notify appropriate person if you will be delayed.
4. Dress professionally.
5. Be courteous and friendly to staff; they can make or break your rotation.
6. Discuss what you wish to achieve each day with the faculty/resident you are working with before the session starts.
7. Read up on problems you have seen and be prepared to present them to your preceptors when asked.
8. Communicate any concerns to your responsible faculty or resident quickly.
9. Ask for regular feedback. Meet with your responsible faculty for mid-month and end of the month for formal evaluation.
10. All patient encounters are confidential. Be careful about what you say and where you say it.
11. Perfect attendance is expected. Missed sessions which are not made up should be discussed with rotation coordinator and program director.
